Sometimes we are all a little "fruity", others just plain "nutty". However according to the scriptures, we are supposed to be "full of the fruit" and I'm not talking Juicy fruit.

As the world keeps speeding through this new trajectory, we saw from King Solomon that nothing is new under the Sun, what goes around, comes around and history repeats itself. That being said, what is happening today has happened before. So, how do we as Christians navigate through these waters?

The media is sure pushing an agenda and a description of Christianity and trust me, if you have read or heard any of it, it is not in a good light. They are trying to change and move people in a direction through shame, fear and lies. Now as we all know, there are always radicals and craziness on every far extreme of every scale. Again, that is not new either. But what does it mean to be a Christian regardless of the time or space you are living in? What is the difference between living a life of Change vs. Justification?

Paul tells us in the book of Galatians Chapter 5. We know it as the fruits of the Spirit. But it is much, much more than fun tantalizing treat. When you dig in and study these characteristics, we see that it is the embodiment of Christ. Love, Joy, Peace, Perseverance, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-control. True Change is when we take "Church" Christ with us when we try to grow in these fruits of the Spirit and allow the Holy Spirit to change us from within. When that happens, then.... We can be assured we are displaying the attributes of Christ and Christianity to the World.
