

You might be one that has said I would like to read Revelation, but I just won't understand it, or it is scary, or all just a mystery. Actually, you would be wrong on all accounts. Most of everything that is penned in this last book of the Bible is referenced throughout all of the Old Testament, spoken through God's prophets, apostles and talked about by Christ himself. This book is a lot more black and white than one might think, and a lot more literal than just figurative.


